On February 1st, we sent out a message on behalf of SABPA to call for your donation in support of the fight against the 2019-nCoV outbreak. Thanks to your generosity, we received more than \$10,000 within just a week. We are happy to let you know that, in collaboration with ACCEF, your donation has been used to purchase five ventilators delivered directly to two hospitals in the epicenter of the outbreak. We received positive feedback from the medical staff that the ventilators are indeed in high demand and used to save lives of patients in critical condition.
